Primary Programme

Candidates must have a good degree with a minimum of a 2:2 classification plus English, Maths & Science at a GCSE grade C or 4.

We are looking for candidates who want to make a difference to the lives of children and have a genuine passion for teaching.

Middle years programme

This Initial Teacher Training programme enables trainees to gain experience in teaching lower Secondary age and upper Primary age pupils.

It is designed to bring subject specialists into the Primary teaching workforce and also to enable those working in Secondary schools a good grounding in how to support those children who may be coming up into Secondary who are working below age expectations.

The tuition fee programme will include a placement in the Autumn term in year 5 or 6, followed by a placement for the Spring term in a Secondary School teaching your specialist subject to Key Stage 3.

After Easter you return to your Primary placement to teach in year 3 or 4.

Secondary programme

This programme is suitable for graduates that wish to gain QTS for employment in Secondary Schools.

The Tuition fee programme will include 2 placements with the first one from September to December and then January to July in a contrasting Secondary school.

For this programme you would be eligible for the Secondary tax-free bursary rates for your specialist subject.

Requirements

Qualifications

Candidates must have a good Degree with a minimum of 2:2 classification (or equivalent)
Maths and English at GCSE C /L4

We require 50 % of your undergraduate degree to be in the subject that you wish to teach in the Secondary phase or a good A level pass at grade B or better and evidence of continued subject knowledge development.
